Membership Renewal and Board of Directors Ballot

May 31, 2019

Dear A.B.S.A. Member,

It's that time of year again to close out the 2018-2019 year for the club and to renew memberships for the next year.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP: Let's start off with some good news; there are no fee increases for this upcoming year! In fact, the Board has voted to reduce some fees to add spouses to the indoor range and to the long range. The 2019-2020 Single Member Annual Membership fee is still \$75, and the fee to add a legal spouse is only an additional \$25. To add a spouse onto your indoor membership, the fee to add a spouse has decreased to \$25 (down from \$50) and the fee to add a spouse to your long range membership has decreased to \$50 (down from \$100). If your spouse has not received official orientation, then of course, your spouse will need to receive the Club's orientation as with all new members. The Club is a family oriented venue and the Board wants to meet its mission to ensure your spouse can enjoy the facility with you.

If you participated one of the club's work parties during the 2018-2019 membership year, you will be given a credit of \$25 off your Annual Membership fees, which reduces your Annual Membership fee to \$50. If this applies to you, you will see a sticker on you renewal submission form stating that "You may deduct \$25 off your total dues since you attended a work party." The Board has voted to continue with this work party credit during the upcoming 2019-2020 year as well. All fees are due by June 30, 2019.

Note: The NEW combination will be installed on the main gate & indoor range & long range gate on JULY 31, 2019 and will be good through June 30, 2020. The new combination will be found on the back of your new membership badge.

WORK PARTY: As a reminder, the work parties started up again in May, and will occur on the 3rd Saturday of the month starting at 8:00AM throughout the spring, summer and fall. For more information, please check out the Club's website or contact one of the Board members for additional details. This is a great way to help keep the Club's property in good condition and also a great way for you to earn a \$25 credit toward your annual membership fee.

INDOOR RANGE: The Indoor Range fee will remain at \$50 per year. Your membership fees go toward maintaining the indoor range, **including upgrades that will allow the use of full metal jacket ammunition.** This is a significant upgrade as the Board has heard from multiple members who want to use FMJ ammo, and this will be in place for the 2019-2020 year!

TRAP HOUSE: The Club has repaired the trap machine and it is in good working order. Expect the Sunday morning trap league to start up again in May. Keep an eye on the Club calendar for details.

SECURITY: The Club is upgrading its security camera system throughout the premises to ensure that the Club is a safe place for its members, guests.

1100 YARD RANGE: The long range has been a huge hit this past year. There are a number of targets placed at varying distances from 500 yards and scattered out to the 1100 yard. The club is hosting long range competitions throughout this summer and fall.

LEAGUES: Please check out the Club’s website for current information, but some of the leagues that are hosted at the Club include:

MEETINGS:

- This is a member-driven club and you have an opportunity to attend the monthly membership meetings the last Thursday of the month at 6:00 PM. This is your opportunity to discuss anything Club related that’s on your mind. The Club looks forward to seeing you at the next members meeting.
- The Annual Membership Meeting for Election Ballots count will be held at the Clubhouse, on Thursday, August 29, 2019 at 5:00 PM. A Board of Directors Meeting will follow the membership meeting. There is a lot going on with the club and the Board of Directors wants your input. It's YOUR club and now is the time for your input and suggestions.

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KEEP THESE REGULATIONS WITH YOUR PAPERS

Work Program

1. Work parties will be scheduled every 3rd Saturday of the month. All work parties will start at 8:00 A.M.
2. If you participate in one work party, you will receive a \$25 credit on the following year's annual renewal.

Guest / Visitor Pass and Waiver Policy

1. All guests shall pay five dollars (\$5.00) per visit for use of the indoor range or outdoor lower rifle range (300 yard range) so long as the accompanying club member is in current standing with either of these facilities. The guest fee for the long range (1100 yard range) is \$20 and must be accompanied by a member who is in current standing with the long range facility.
2. With the exception of immediate family, **spouse and children under 18 years of age**, (a spouse who is an avid shooter should consider membership) a member will not bring more than **two (2) guests** at one time on to club property however. Waivers and \$5 or \$20 (described above) are to be deposited in boxes that are available in the indoor range of the Club House and in the shed near the road to the Skeet Field.
3. **Club member and adult guests shall execute a Liability Waiver upon entering club grounds.** The waiver shall be witnessed by the club member escorting the guest. **The guest and club member** shall also complete the adhesive Guest Pass which shall be conspicuously displayed on the guest while on club property.
4. All League Captains shall be responsible to assure that nonmember participants execute the waiver for up to the end of League activity for the season.
